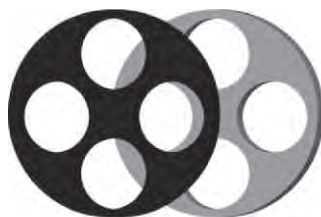

Schedule of Classes

Best exhibitor bred animal will be selected in each class.

Animals with the best udder will be selected in classes 5 - 9.

Entry fee £15 per animal per class with the exception of **Class 1, which is FREE**

CLASSES

1. **Showmanship Class** - Calf to be led by a handler aged 18 years and under, (Class may be split on the night).
 2. **Heifer Calf** - Born on or after 1st December 2016 (No restriction to age of handler)
 3. **Heifer Calf** - Born between 1st August 2016 and 30th November 2016. (No restrictions to age of handler)
 4. **Maiden Heifer** - Born between 1st April 2016 and 31st July 2016. (No restriction to age of handler)
- S.P.I. **Champion Calf** - Winners of classes 2 - 4 are eligible; champion will be awarded the Michael Armstrong Perpetual Trophy by the Armstrong Family, Wolfa in memory of Michael.
- 5.a/ 5.b. **2 year old** - 1st October 2014 - 30th September 2015. (This class may be split on the night depending on the number of entries).
- SP2 **Junior Champion** - to be judged at this point in the evening.
6. **3 year old** - 1st October 2013 - 30th September 2014
 7. **4 year old** - 1st October 2012 - 30th September 2013
 8. **Mature Cow** - Born prior to 1st October 2012. (This class may be split depending on the number of entries).

N.B. Please note estimated time for judging of the In-Milk classes is approximately 7:15pm

Schedule of Special Awards

Entries for Special Awards are to be made on the evening of the show.

9. **Best New Exhibitor Award** - Prize awarded to the new exhibitor with the most points in the show and has not shown in the last 5 years.
10. **Premier Breeders Award** - Breeder with the most points in the show.
11. **Premier Exhibitors Award** - Exhibitor with the most points in the show.

NB for Classes 11 and 12 - Excludes animals in joint ownership

12. **Best Udder In The Show** - Animals with the best udder in classes 5 - 9 are eligible to enter.
13. **Grand Champion** - All 1st & 2nd prize winners are eligible. **£100 and the Northern Expo Trophy**. The grand Champion will be granted **FREE** stall entry at Agri-Scot on Wed 15th November.
14. **Reserve Champion** - All 1st & 2nd prize winners are eligible
15. **Best Exhibitor Bred Animal** - Champion exhibitor bred animal from the qualifying championships are eligible to enter.
16. **Herdsperson In Charge of the Grand Champion**

Show Rules & Information

Please read carefully before completing your entry form.

1. **Rules** - The show is conducted under the rules set by Holstein UK.
2. **Entry Fees - Class 1 - FREE**
Classes 2 - 10: £15.00 per animal per class
Special Awards: FREE
3. **Closing Date for Entries - Monday 21st August 2017** for cataloguing. **Late Entries** will be accepted at **£20 per entry up until 12 Noon on Thursday 31st August**, but **will not be catalogued**.
4. **Method of Entry** - All entries must be made on the official entry form and must be sent to the Secretary:- Anna Stable, Bolton Manor Farm, Little Urswick, Ulverston, Cumbria, LA12 0PX. Or emailed to northerndairyexpo@gmail.com
5. **Substitutes** - Will be permitted by **12 p.m.** on the day of the show. A steward will be responsible for obtaining details of substitute entries.
6. **Classes** - The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split classes depending on the number of entries.
7. **Class Winners** - All 1st Prize Winners, Champions & Res. Champions must remain in the ring following their presentation for a photograph with the Class Sponsors. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiting of prizes for that class.
8. **Exhibitor Bred** - For the purpose of this year's show any animal born on the exhibitors farm and carrying his or her own prefix will be deemed to be exhibitor bred.
9. **Disclaimer** - The Northern Expo Show Committee, it's Officers, Servants or Agents, whether negligent or not, shall not be liable for any claims or loss or damage by an exhibitor or visitor in relation to the show.
10. **Disputes** - The ruling of the Show Committee in relation to all matters concerning this show is final. All disputes are to be logged in writing on the evening of the show with a fee of £50
11. **Vets Fees** - Any fees incurred for animals which are treated by the vet whilst attending the Northern Expo Show must be settled by the exhibitors.
12. **New Exhibitor** - A class to be based on the New Exhibitor to the Northern Expo Show with the most points (Not to have shown in the last five years)
13. **TB Status** - If your herd is currently on a 1 or 2 year testing regime, you must pre-test the animals entered and provide the committee with a copy of you test certificate (test for show animals must be within 60 days of the show date)
14. **Identification of Exhibits** - All exhibits must be identified in their stalls by the official cow cards provided.
15. **Dress** - All leaders must wear white trousers and shirts in the ring.
16. **Milking Facilities** - These are available, but please bring your own milking units.
17. **Washing Facilities** - Hot and cold water will be available.
18. **Bedding** - Straw is provided but rubbish must not be put in with the dirty bedding.
19. **Certification** - Registration certificates and passports must accompany all exhibits.
20. **Timetable** - Cattle may come into the auction premises from **12pm Friday 1st September** (day of the show). Due to restrictions it will not be possible for cattle the day before the show this year.
21. **Gates** - These must not be removed.
22. **All rubbish must be in the bins provided** - the straw used for bedding is spread on fields so rubbish must not be mixed.
23. **Will all exhibitors** please note this show is subject to the 6 day movement rules.
